

## June 2022 Update for 4H/FFA Youth Exhibitors Participating in the Premium Livestock Sale

### Support of the Jr. Fair Sale

Thank you for your willingness to assist with the 2022 Premium Livestock Sale. It is a tremendous benefit to our youth exhibitors and takes significant effort to accomplish. All youth exhibitors and/or an adult family member are expected to **select at least one time slot** to assist with the 2022 Jr. Fair Livestock sale. Please look carefully at the requirements for each slot to determine if the task requires an adult or youth and sign up accordingly. Youth exhibitors should plan to wear their Fair T-Shirt when working at the sale. Please also try to select a time that would likely not conflict with your own sale. For reference, the sale will begin promptly at 9:00 am and the sale order will be as follows: Swine, Goats, Sheep, Poultry, Rabbits, Beef and Dairy.

Training for most tasks will be provided in real time. Additional training (< 1 hour) will be required for those that are processing payments and/or entering add on payments. Those that select these slots will be contacted in advance to arrange that training.

Please note – for those that sign up on Friday evening, sale ring prep will begin immediately after the Showman of Showman competition ends to please be flexible about timing!

### **W-9 Tax Forms**

- Per regulations of the IRS, all sale monies in excess of \$600 (this does not include the market price if your animal is going to the packer) are reportable for tax purposes.
- Every youth exhibitor who sells in the Premium Livestock Sale MUST have a W-9 on file or they will NOT be permitted to sell.
- Additional information about the submission of W-9 forms will be shared prior to check in.

### **Animal Check In**

- When you check your animal in at the fair, you will need to be prepared to make a final decision on the destination of your animal(s). Although this information was submitted at the time of entry, we recognize that circumstances may have changed. No changes will be permissible after your species check in.

## July 2022 – Exhibitor Check In

### Update for 4H/FFA Youth Exhibitors Participating in the Premium Livestock Sale

#### Animal Check In

- When you check your animal in at the fair, you will need to be prepared to make a final decision on the destination of your animal(s). Although this information was submitted at the time of entry, we recognize that circumstances may have changed. **No changes will be permissible after your species check in.**

#### W9 Requirement

- In order to sell in the sale on Saturday, **it is required that each exhibitor have a W9 on file.** W9 forms will be collected at species check in. If you are checking in more than one species, you may turn in your W9 at any one of the check in locations. W9 forms should be completed and placed in sealed envelopes with the exhibitors name on the outside of the envelope.

#### Sale Day – Saturday July 16, 2022

- **We plan to start the sale promptly at 9 am.** Sale order will be as follows: Swine, Goats, Sheep, Poultry, Rabbits, Beef and Dairy. Grand Showman of Showman will sell at 1 pm; Grand, Reserve, Species Showman of Showman and Premier Exhibitors will sell first with their respective species. The sale order will be finalized by Friday afternoon prior to the sale and the first several swine exhibitors should be prepared to check in PRIOR to the 9 am start. If you are late or miss your spot in the sale order, you will NOT be permitted to sell at a later time.
- **If you win either Grand or Reserve Champion** for your sale species, you will be REQUIRED to move your animal to the Franklin Building behind the Eby Arena for viewing on Friday evening, July 15, 2022 by 7 pm. In addition, for those that win Grand or Reserve, you will be given the opportunity to bring your animal into the Livestock Sale when it is your time to sell.
- We have asked that each youth exhibitor or an adult family member sign up to assist at the Livestock sale on Saturday. There are still plenty of options and we look forward to working with you Saturday to execute a very successful sale. If you have not yet signed up, please go the following link to sign up.
