2023 Prospective Royalty and Specie Ambassador Applicants:

Thank you for applying to become the "face" of the Madison County Fair. Having a title for the Madison County Fair is both fun and hard work. You will be required to appear at events throughout the year and not just at fair. As a very visible role model, an extremely high standard has been set for your behavior, attitude and appearance (dress code).

Applications: Due Thursday, June 15: As you fill out your application please remember that someone has to read it, therefore, be as neat as possible – Typewritten would be the best. The 5x7 photo needs to be PRINTED and submitted with the application. Be sure the headshot photo is clear and suitable for publication & display during the fair. The royalty applicants must submit a biography for publication.

Interviews will begin at Noon Sunday, July 9th: All royalty contestants must participate in an in-person interview. No electronic interviews will be conducted. Contestants should wear interview-style attire (suit, nice dress, dressy slacks/pants outfit). Be sure that hair, makeup, and accessories compliment the outfit and are not overdone or distracting.

Stage Competition; Sunday, July 9, 2023, 5 PM, Della: Check-in will be from 4:00-4:30 PM. You will be REQUIRED TO TURN IN YOUR FULLY COMPLETED FAIR WEEK SCHEDULING FORM PRIOR TO THE COMPETITION. The Conference room will be available for preparation at 4 PM. Royalty Contestants need to wear formal clothes for ladies. These need to be floor length with no deep plunging necklines, high splits more than 3 inches above the knee, and no see-through or bare midriffs. Gentlemen need to wear suits or very dressy pants and button-down dress shirts. Boots are not appropriate for this competition.

Mandatory Crowning Night Meeting; Sunday, July 10, 2022, Conference Room: This meeting will begin about 20 minutes after the end of the crowning to allow time for photos. Each ambassador & royalty member must attend with a parent. Please, no extra siblings or friends. Light snacks will be provided. During this meeting, we will go over expectations and do scheduling for fair week. Dress code & appropriate behaviors will be strictly enforced. Contact information must be completed & turned in before leaving.
