Record keeping is a very important part of the 4-H program. The 4-H program begins with the Cloverbud program and so does the record keeping! Keeping accurate records now of your events, activities, and awards will make life much easier as you progress through the 4-H program when applying for state recognition and even in preparing college entrance & scholarship applications. These records are also helpful for many applications and records outside of the 4-H/Cloverbud Program.

Use these record pages to keep track of your Cloverbud experiences. Copy and add to them as needed. Similar record sheets are available for 4-H members and older youth. Be sure to keep your record pages together and where you can find them easily. Photos with captions are also very important to keep with your records. I strongly encourage you to keep labeled photos with your record pages along with the negatives or photo CD.
