RETURNING VOLUNTEERS

- ✓ Re-enroll in 4-H Online by March 15 via oh.4honline.com
- ✓ Review and sign the 4-H Volunteer Standards of Behavior and commit to upholding those standards (Completed via 4-H Online)
- ✓ Submit a Background Check every 3-4 years (Due by March 15, 2022)
- ✓ Complete mandatory training/club update

Training Requirements

- 1. Complete one of the following options:
- <u>OPTION A:</u> NEW FOR 2023: There will be an Online Course option for volunteers to complete at your own pace to watch video recordings, answer quizzes, etc. (~1 hour of videos total).

- <u>OPTION B:</u> Live Training (Zoom or In-Person).

- Complete an interview with the 4-H Extension Educator.
- Complete a Criminal History Fingerprint/Background Check

- <u>Financial Statement</u> Due January 31
- Cross County Membership Request Forms due February 15
- Ohio 4-H Club Charter Checklist due March 15
- Club Activity Fees due March 15

Returning Volunteer Training Online Course Access Instructions

Step 1: Visit the Self-Registration Link: <u>go.osu.edu/madcovolunteercourse</u>

Step 2: Fill out the registration form. Name and email address is required (must have a unique email for each volunteer). You can enter "0" for phone and zip code if you wish. Enter "NA" for title and company.

*If you already have a Canvas account, you can select the "Sign in to Enroll" blue button at the top of the registration screen. If you did the Policy 1.50 course online in previous years, you would already have an account. If you forgot your password, there are prompts to reset it.




Step 3: After completing the registration form, you will receive 2 emails from Canvas Catalog. One asks you to complete your registration by adding a password to your account. The other confirms your enrollment in the course. Be sure to follow both links.

Step 4: After creating your account, you can begin the course! We recommend bookmarking the page so you can come back to it and complete it on your own time.

You must complete ALL THREE MODULES and all items. It will check them off as you go. Items must be completed in the order they are listed. Be sure to complete the video, quiz, and survey for completion for each module.

The course must be completed by **March 15**, **2023**.


